




**NOTICE OF MEETING**

Pecan Dr., Johnson City, Blanco County, Texas, and simulcasted live online at [www.YouTube.com](http://www.YouTube.com) , channel "Blanco County", at which time the following subjects shall be discussed and action considered and/or taken thereon:


