ORDER TO RELEASE BURN BAN

Blanco County Judge Brett Bray has issued this order that as of Thursday, September 06, 2018, at 2:00 p.m., the burn ban for Blanco County has been lifted.

The action to lift the burn ban came after consultation with the Chiefs of the three fire departments in the County who agreed that the amount of moisture we have had recently, together with the forecast for higher humidity, the possibility of some additional rain, and more stable conditions for the coming weekend, present a good opportunity for people to take care of some of the burning that needs to be done.

Judge Bray advised that even though we are still in severe drought conditions, with a significant potential for wildfires, the Commissioners Court, along with the fire departments in the County, want to work with the general public to accomplish some necessary burning while conditions are more favorable. Everyone is requested to use extreme caution when burning.
