

ORDER OF THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES DECLARING  
THE POSTPONEMENT OF THE DISTRICT'S MAY 2, 2020 ELECTION  
TO THE NOVEMBER 3, 2020 UNIFORM ELECTION DATE

WHEREAS, the Johnson City Independent School District (the "*District*") is a political subdivision of the State of Texas (the "*State*"); and

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees of the District (the "*Board*") serve staggered three-year terms, the Board elections are held in May of each year (the "*Trustee Election*"), and the District scheduled its current Trustee Election to be held within the boundaries of the District on the May 2, 2020 uniform election date; and

WHEREAS, State and local officials have determined that a State of Emergency exists in Texas due to the public health risks posed by COVID-19; and

WHEREAS, the recent COVID-19 outbreak has resulted in the closure of schools, businesses and other public gathering places statewide and is reasonably anticipated to interfere with the Trustee Election; and

WHEREAS, the District administrators continue to respond to new recommendations and guidance related to public health and safety from national and state educational and public health officials, including the Governor of the State, Gregg Abbott ("*Governor Abbott*") during this rapidly developing situation; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the powers conferred on the Governor of the State, Governor Abbott issued a proclamation on March 13, 2020 certifying that COVID-19 poses an imminent threat of disaster in the state and declaring a state of disaster for all counties in the State; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the powers conferred on the Governor of the State, Governor Abbott issued a proclamation on March 18, 2020 suspending certain provisions of the Texas Election Code and the Texas Water Code to allow all local political subdivisions that are utilizing the May 2, 2020 uniform election date to postpone their election to the November 3, 2020 uniform election date (the "*March 18th Proclamation*"); and

WHEREAS, the Office of the Governor suspended certain provisions of Chapter 551, as amended, Texas Government Code, to allow governmental bodies to conduct meetings via teleconference or video conference, subject to certain provisions of the advisory issued by the Office of the Governor, until such suspension is terminated by the Office of the Governor or the March 13, 2020 disaster declaration is removed or expires;

WHEREAS, the District officials acknowledge and agree that the District is impacted by a state and national public health crisis that is rapidly changing and therefore, the District's primary concern is the health and safety of voters, election workers, and local election officials; and for early voting are October 19, 2020 – October 30, 2020.

This Order shall be construed and enforced in accordance with the laws of the State and the United States of America.


It is officially found, determined, and declared that the meeting at which this Order is adopted was in compliance with the advisory issued by the Office of the Governor and public notice of the time, place, and subject matter of the public business to be considered at such meeting, including this Order, was given, all as required by Chapter 551, as amended, Texas Government Code.

This Order shall be in force and effect from and after the date of its adoption.


