Pecan Dr.</u>, <u>Johnson City</u>, <u>Blanco County</u>, <u>Texas</u>, and simulcasted live online at <u>www.YouTube.com</u>, channel "Blanco County", at which time the following subjects shall be discussed and action considered and/or taken thereon:

- 1. Call to order and roll call.
- 2. Pledge of Allegiance.
- 3. PUBLIC COMMENTS— opportunity for the general public to address the Court on any matter. Comments are limited to 3 minutes.
- 4. Consider approval of minutes of prior Commissioners Court meeting(s). Vote on any action taken. (Judge Bray)
- 5. Consider approval of the estimated December 2020 payroll. Vote on any action taken. (Judge Bray)
- 6. Consider approval of the official reports. Vote on any action taken. (Judge Bray)
- 7. Consider ratifying or approving line item transfers as presented. Vote on any action taken. (Judge Bray)
- 8. Consider approval of the outstanding bills. Vote on any action taken. (Judge Bray)
- 9. Consider approval of the specs and for the purchase of 3 AXON Body cameras for the Blanco County Sheriff's Office as outlined in the LEC section of the FY2020-21 budget. Vote on any action taken. (Judge Bray)

- 10. Open, review and possibly select winning bid for Precinct paving projects. Vote on any action taken. (Commissioners x 4)
- 11. Consider approval to replat lot 17 in Los Encinos subdivision. New lots to be known as lot 17-A and 17-B. Vote on any action taken. (Commissioner Liesmann)
