Blanco County Sheriff's Office has adopted a detailed written policy on racial profiling. Our policy:

- 1.) clearly defines acts constituting racial profiling;
- 2.) strictly prohibit peace officers employed by the Blanco County Sheriff's Office from engaging in racial profiling;
- 3.) implements a process by which an individual may file a complaint with the Blanco County Sheriff's Office if the individual believes that a peace officer employed by the Blanco County Sheriff's Office has engaged in racial profiling with respect to the individual;
- 4.) provides public education relating to the agency's complaint process;
- 5.) requires appropriate corrective action to be taken against a peace officer employed by the Blanco County Sheriff's Office who, after an investigation, is shown to have engaged in racial profiling in violation of the Blanco County Sheriff's Office's policy adopted under this article;
- 6.) require collection of information relating to motor vehicle stops in which a citation is issued and to arrests made as a result of those stops, including information relating to:
 - a.) the race or ethnicity of the individual detained;
 - b.) whether a search was conducted and, if so, whether the individual detained consented to the search: and

detaining that individual; and

7.) require the chief administrator of the agency, regardless of whether the administrator is elected, employed, or appointed, to submit an annual report of the information collected under Subdivision(6) to:

a.) the Commission on Law Enforcement; and

b.) the governing body of each county or municipality served by the agency, if the agency is an agency of a county, municipality, or other political subdivision of the state.

AMENDMENT TO INDUSTRIAL LEASE

This amendment (the "Amendment") is made by Blanco County, Texas, a political subdivision, by and through its Commissioner's Court ("Landlord"), and Waste Connections Lone Star, Inc (FKA Progressive Waste Solutions, Inc, ("Tenant") parties to the agreement Industrial Lease Agreement dated January 1, 2016 (the "Agreement").

The Agreement is amended as follows:

1. Base Rent (Monthly):

The Monthly Base Rent shall be modified to \$2,200 beginning January 1, 2019

2. Termination Date:

The Termination Date shall be modified to December 31, 2023.

3. Amount of Liability Insurance

The amount of Liability Insurance shall be amended to:

Death/bodily injury: _____ each occurrence

Property: _____ each occurrence

4. Section A.S. is deleted and replaced with the following:

Pay a late charge of 5%, or the highest rate allowed by law, whichever is less, of any rent not received by Landlord by the 10th day of each month.

5. Section E.10. is deleted in its entirety and replaced with the following:

Default by Tenant/Events. Default by Tenant are (a) failing to pay timely Rent; (b) abandoning or vacating a substantial portion of the Premises, (c) violating any laws related to the use of the property; and (d) failing to comply within ten days after written notice with any provision of this lease.

6. The following paragraph 23 is added:

Lessee warrants and represents that it will, during the period of its occupancy of the Premises under this Lease, comply with all federal, state and local laws, regulations and ordinances with respect to the use, storage, treatment, disposal or transportation of Hazardous Substances. Lessee shall indemnify and hold Lessor harmless from and against any claims, fines, judgments, penalties, costs, liabilities or losses (including, without limitation, reasonable attorneys' fees and costs at trial and on appeal) arising from the breach of the preceding warranty and representation. For the purposes of this Paragraph, the term Hazardous Substances shall be interpreted broadly to include but not be limited to, substances designated as hazardous under the Resource Conservation and Recovery Act, 42 U.S.C. SS9601, et seq., the Federal Water Pollution Control Act, 33 U.S.C. SS1257, et seq., the Clean Air Act, 42 U.S.C. SS2001, et seq., or the Comprehensive Environmental Response Compensation and Liability Act of 1980, 42 U.S.C. SS9601, et seq., any applicable State Law or regulation. The term shall also be interpreted to include but not be limited to any


substance which after release into the environment and upon exposure, ingestion, inhalation or assimilation, either directly from the environment or directly by ingestion through food chains, will or may reasonably be anticipated to cause death, disease, behavior abnormalities, cancer and/or genetic abnormalities, and oil and petroleum based derivatives. At the end of the lease term, or any renewal term, Lessee shall leave the premises clean of any hazardous waste. Any hazardous waste created as a result of the Lessees occupancy of the premises shall be the sole responsibility of the Lessee. All clean up, fines, penalties, etc. shall be paid for by the Lessee. Lessee shall indemnify and hold Lessor harmless from and against any claims, damages, costs, expenses or actions which arise out of any breach of this provision. The provisions of this Paragraph shall be in addition to any other obligations or liabilities Lessee may have to Lessor at law and equity and shall survive termination of this Lease.

Except as set forth in this Amendment, the Agreement is unaffected and shall continue in full force and effect in accordance with its terms. If there is conflict between this amendment and the Agreement or any earlier amendment, the terms of this amendment will prevail.
