ORDER AND NOTICE OF INCORPORATION ELECTION

ON THIS 31 day of JANUARY 2025, came on to be considered the application filed in the office of the County Judge of Blanco County, Texas, on the 14th day of May 2024, seeking to incorporate the City of Hobbes, Texas.


AND IT APPEARING that said application is in due form of law; that same is signed by more than 10% of the qualified voters of the area sought to be incorporated, who are qualified voters under §11.002 of the Texas Election Code; that the boundaries of the proposed city are duly set forth, and a proper legal description thereof accompanies said application, applicable thereto, and that there are more than 200 and less than 4,999 inhabitants inhabiting the territory within the proposed City of Hobbes, Texas, is intended and suitable to be used strictly for city purposes, and that, on the basis thereof, the inhabitants of said territory are entitled by law to incorporate themselves into a city, if a majority of them vote in favor of such incorporation.

IT IS, THEREFORE, ORDERED that an election be held on the 3rd day of May, 2025, in Blanco County, Texas, which is situated within the territory described in said application, for the purpose of submitting to the qualified voters of such territory, the question of the incorporation of the City of Hobbes, Texas, under the provisions of Chapter 8 of the Texas Local Government Code.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that an election be held on the 3rd day of May, 2025, in Blanco County, Texas, which is situated within the territory described in said application, for the purpose of electing a Mayor and two City Commissioners of the City of Hobbes, Texas, under the provisions of §24.021 of the Local Government Code.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Blanco County Election Administrator shall appoint two election judges and two election clerks to assist in holding said election.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Blanco County Election Administrator shall cause notice of said election be posted at three (3) public places in said territory for ten (10) days previous to the date of said election and said election shall be held and conducted as prescribed by the general laws of this State governing general elections.
