




NOTICE OF MEETING

Pecan Dr, Johnson City, Blanco County, Texas,** at which time the following subjects shall be discussed and action considered and/or taken thereon:

2. Pledge of Allegiance.
3. Consider burn ban. Vote on any action taken. (Judge Bray)
4. Consider line item transfer. Vote on any action taken. (Judge Bray)
5. Consider on-going discussions regarding budget items for FY 2019-20. Vote on any action taken. (Judge Bray)
6. Consider proposing a tax rate of .3970 per \$100 valuation. Vote on any action taken. (Judge Bray)
