




NOTICE OF MEETING

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN pursuant to Chapter 551 of the Texas Government Code (the Texas Open Meetings Act) that a Special meeting of the Blanco County Commissioners Court shall be held on **Tuesday, October 27, 2020** at **9:00 a.m.** in the Commissioners Courtroom of the Blanco County Courthouse located at 101 E. Pecan Dr., Johnson City, Blanco County, Texas, and simulcasted live online at www.YouTube.com , channel “Blanco County”, at which time the following subjects shall be discussed and action considered and/or taken thereon:

1. Call to order and roll call.
2. Pledge of Allegiance.
3. PUBLIC COMMENTS– opportunity for the general public to address the Court on any matter. Comments are limited to 3 minutes.
4. Remarks on supplemental compensation and on Emergency Management. Informational item only. (Judge Bray)
5. Consider approval of minutes of prior Commissioners Court meeting(s). Vote on any action taken. (Judge Bray)
6. Consider ratifying or approving line item transfers as presented. Vote on any action taken. (Judge Bray)
7. Consider approval of the outstanding bills. Vote on any action taken. (Judge Bray)
8. Consider authorization for the County Judge to sign the liability insurance renewal questionnaire with Texas Association of Counties (TAC). Vote on any action taken. (Judge Bray)
9. Consider authorization for the County Judge to sign the Interlocal Cooperation Contract for DPS General Stores supplies including but not limited to Alcohol Blood Test Kits. Vote on any action taken. (Judge Bray)

10. Consider authorization for the County Judge to sign the amendment for the FY2020-21 Johnson Controls annual service and support contract. Vote on any action taken. (Judge Bray)
