




NOTICE OF MEETING

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN pursuant to Chapter 551 of the Texas Government Code (the Texas Open Meetings Act) that a Regular meeting of the Blanco County Commissioners Court shall be held on **Tuesday, March 12, 2019** at **9:00 a.m.** in the Commissioners Courtroom of the Blanco County Courthouse located at 101 E. Pecan Dr., Johnson City, Blanco County, Texas, at which time the following subjects shall be discussed and action considered and/or taken thereon:

1. Call to order and roll call.
2. Pledge of Allegiance.
3. Consider approval of minutes of prior Commissioners Court meeting(s). Vote on any action taken. (Judge Bray)
4. PUBLIC COMMENTS– opportunity for the general public to address the Court on any matter. Comments are limited to 2 minutes.
5. Consider approval of the estimated March 2019 payroll. Vote on any action taken. (Judge Bray)
6. Consider approval of the official reports. Vote on any action taken. (Judge Bray)
7. Consider ratifying or approving line item transfers as presented. Vote on any action taken. (Judge Bray)
8. Consider approval of the outstanding bills. Vote on any action taken. (Judge Bray)
9. Consider approval to replat lot 1 in the Cambridge 14-15 subdivision. New lots to be known as lots 1-A and 1-B. Vote on any action taken. (Commissioner Granberg)

10. Consider approval to replat lots 1 & 2 in the One River Point subdivision. New lot to be known as lot 1-R. Vote on any action taken. (Commissioner Liesmann)

19. Adjourn.


