2024 Texas Water Development Board Flood Infrastructure Fund Grant Opportunity

Blanco County is eligible to receive up to a <u>75% state match</u> for eligible Flood Mitigation Evaluations (FMEs – planning, design, permitting) that were included in the amended Guadalupe Regional Flood Plan in Summer 2023. The local match could be split between other potential stakeholders (e.g., GBRA, municipalities, etc.), covered by 0% TWDB loans, and spread out over multiple fiscal years, but those details don't need to be worked out until after the abridged application period. The 2024 FIF would be an excellent opportunity to keep moving forward with flood mitigation project planning, design, and construction at a significantly reduced cost to the County.

Abridged Applications, which are due to TWDB by <u>April 15th, 2024</u>, will be reviewed and ranked by TWDB based on several factors (e.g., existing flood risk and reduction potential at structures / population / crossings / roads, benefit-cost ratio, etc.) and sponsors for top-ranking applications will be invited to submit Final Applications later this year. 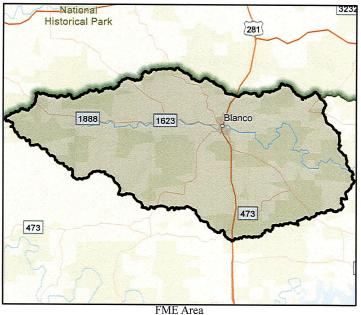
