RENTAL OF PREMISES

In consideration of the mutual covenants and agreements of this Rental Agreement, and other good and valuable consideration, County agrees to rent to Renter the outside grounds of the Courthouse, located at 101 E. Pecan Drive, Johnson City, Texas 78636 (the "Premises"). The Premises shall also include the parking spaces directly adjacent to the Courthouse grounds along E. Pecan Dr. and N. Avenue G. The rental term shall be effective from Saturday, November 11, 2023 at 12:00 a.m. through 11:59 p.m.

CONSIDERATION

RELEASE OF LIABILITY AND INDEMNITY AGREEMENT

In consideration of being granted permission to erect or have erected vendor edifices on certain Blanco County property, the receipt and sufficiency of which is hereby acknowledged, said certain property (the Property) to be specified below at the sole discretion of the County Judge or his designee/s, the Lights Spectacular organization (LIGHTS SPECTACULAR) hereby enters into this RELEASE OF LIABILITY AND INDEMNITY AGREEMENT (Agreement) as of the execution date set forth below.

- ACKNOWLEDGMENT OF RISKS: LIGHTS SPECTACULAR recognizes and understands the 1. risks associated with sponsorship of vendor events, including, but not limited to, bodily injury or death to persons, and damage to property. LIGHTS SPECTACULAR further acknowledges and understands that LIGHTS SPECTACULAR will be held liable for any and all damage to persons, vehicles, property, real property and/or improvements to property caused by LIGHTS SPECTACULAR and/or any persons (including, but not limited to, minors) under their care and control and/or invited, actually or constructively, by LIGHTS SPECTACULAR, and/or that rise out of, or are related to, LIGHTS SPECTACULAR's its directors, officers, employees, volunteers, representatives, agents, contractors, activity holders, sponsors, and volunteers, members, guests or invitees entry onto the Property before, during or after the event.
