Upon completion of the 4th year of employment, an employee shall receive a one-time, two percent (2.00%) salary increase over and above any annual increases granted by the Commissioners Court during their regular budget process. Upon completion of the 6th year of employment and all subsequent years, an employee shall receive a one percent (1.00%) salary increase over and above any annual increases granted by the Commissioners Court during their regular budget process.
- d. Any employee that terminates employment with Blanco County and is subsequently rehired in the same or another position with the County shall begin the longevity process anew and shall lose any previous longevity that may have accrued.
