Pecan Dr, Johnson City, Blanco County, Texas,** at which time the following subjects shall be discussed and action considered and/or taken thereon:

Consider appointment of the following individuals to service a two-year term beginning January 1, 2018 to December 31, 2019 on the South Blanco County EDS board: Carl Struck and Lynne McKirdy also Becky Greathouse for a one-year term to fill the vacancy by Dan Brandenstein's resignation which ends on December 31, 2018. Vote on any action taken. (Judge Bray)
