- 3. Consider setting the salaries for the elected officials for FY 2017-18. Vote on any action taken. (Judge Bray)
- 4. Consider setting the base salaries for new employees for FY 2017-18. Vote on any action taken. (Judge Bray)
- 5. Consider adoption of the Blanco County budget for FY 2017-18. Vote on any action taken. (Judge Bray)
- 6. Consider setting the tax rate for FY 2017-18 at \$0.3970 of which \$0.0519 is for debt service. Vote on any action taken. (Judge Bray)
- 7. Consider ratifying the tax increase of \$559,626.00 for FY 2017-18. Vote on any action taken. (Judge Bray)
- 8. Consider setting the homestead exemption at 1% of the appraised value with a minimum exemption of \$5000.00. Vote on any action taken. (Judge Bray)
