

INTERLOCAL COOPERATION AGREEMENT

STATE OF TEXAS)

COUNTY OF BLANCO)

This Agreement is entered into by and between the County of Blanco (herein called County) and the City of Johnson City (herein called City), all political subdivisions of the State of Texas, pursuant to the Interlocal Cooperation Act, Tex. Gov't. Code, Section 791.001 et seq.

WITNESSETH

WHEREAS, the parties to this Agreement desire to jointly provide certain Governmental functions and services in which the parties are mutually interest; and

WHEREAS, all parties agree that it is in their best interest and in the best interest of their respective citizens to participate in this Agreement.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS AGREED AS FOLLOWS:

ARTICLE I

PURPOSE

The purpose of this Agreement is to allow the parties to provide, to the other party, certain "Governmental functions and services" as defined in Section 791.003 of the Tex. Gov't Code, including but not limited to: (1) provide equipment and manpower; (2) provide emergency

management resources, and (3) provide 911 emergency addressing information and resources.

Each party's responsibility is limited by the availability of the party's assets and resources.

ARTICLE II

TERM

The term of this Agreement is for a period of one (1) year, commencing on the date of execution of this Agreement. The Agreement may be renewed for additional terms upon the written agreement of the parties.

Any party may, upon written notice to all other parties, withdraw from this Agreement at any time upon 30 days written notice to all other parties.

ARTICLE III

CONSIDERATION

The consideration is the mutual covenants contained herein.

ARTICLE IV

ALLOCATION OF FUNDS/GRANTS

In further recognition of the benefit to be gained by parties to this agreement, it is agreed that a party to this Agreement shall not request reimbursement for any services performed pursuant to this agreement by another party to this agreement.

ARTICLE V

RESPONSIBILITY

No party to this Agreement shall be responsible for the civil acts of another party except as may be decreed by a judgment of a court of competent jurisdiction.

It is expressly understood and agreed that, in the execution of this Agreement, no party waives, nor shall be deemed hereby to waive, any immunity or defense that would otherwise be available to it against claims arising in the exercise of government powers and functions.

ARTICLE VI

AMENDMENTS

This Agreement may be amended by the mutual agreement of the parties hereto in a writing to be attached to and incorporated into this Agreement.

ARTICLE VII

LEGAL CONSTRUCTION

In case any one or more of the provisions contained in this Agreement shall be held to be invalid, illegal or unenforceable in any respect, such invalidity, illegality or unenforceability shall not affect any other provision, hereof and the Agreement shall be construed as if such invalid, illegal or unenforceable provision had never been contained herein.

ARTICLE VIII

ENTIRE AGREEMENT

This Agreement supersedes any and all other agreements, either oral or in writing, between

the parties hereto with respect to the Purpose stated herein.

EXECUTED in duplicate originals, each of which shall have the full force and effect of an original. This Agreement is effective when fully executed by all parties.
